Hudson St. Croix RiverFest Celebrates Ho-Chunk Nation's Cultural Heritage

On Saturday, July 20, the Hudson St. Croix RiverFest celebrated community and culture with a special contribution from the Ho-Chunk.

This year's event featured the Ho-Chunk Drum & Dance Troupe and Anne Thundercloud of Wild Bearies, who shared traditions through song, dance, cooking, and storytelling.

The event began with performances by the Iron Mound Singers and Dancers from the Ho-Chunk Nation, followed by the St. Croix Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin, who showcased their own dances, songs, and drumming. Native American food was available for sale, provided by the Mosay family.

Anne Thundercloud, a member of the Ho-Chunk Nation and Wild Bearies chef apprentice, led a class called Indigenous Culinary Traditions: Cooking with Anne Thundercloud at Grand Fête.

Later, she hosted a meet and greet at the Black Rooster Bistro, discussing how Indigenous cuisine

This mural was a popular attraction, allowing people of all ages to participate and learn about Ho-Chunk heritage.

The mural featured vibrant colors and intricate designs symbolizing unity and community spirit. The mural depicted the river and feathers representing the 12 Ho-Chunk Clans. Attendees enjoyed adding their personal touches to the mural, creating a beautiful, collective artwork.

The Ho-Chunk Drum & Dance Troupe performed, entertaining the audience with traditional songs and dance. Their performances were a highlight of the festival.

Reminder to schedule your child's Sports Physicals, Head Start, or Kindergarten physicals!

Please schedule your child's Sports Physical, Head Start, or Kindergarten Physical soon, to ensure a good start to their school year.

For **Head Start** or **Kindergarten Physicals**, please see your school's requirements as to how far ahead of their start date they can accept a physical.

Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association Sports Physicals are good for a duration of time depending on when they were done:

- If a sports physical is done before April 1st they are only good for the next school year.
- If a sports physical is done April 1st to the end of the year, it is good for the remainder of that school year and the following school year. An alternate year card is required to be completed by the parent or guardian for the second year.

Purslane

ABOUT PURSLANE

- Purslane is a very common "weed" during the heat of summer. It grows in all types of soil. If you garden, you probably have it! It grows in full sun.
- Purslane is very wide spread, and used as food or medicine in many cultures around the world.
- Purslane is very nutrient-dense. It is high in plant-based omega-3 fatty acids and contains significant amounts of vitamin A and C.
- Purslane can be eaten raw or cooked. It can be used like any other green, and added to salads or sandwiches.
- Leaves are tender and edible most of summer. The stems, leaves and flower buds have a tart and salty taste.
- Purslane has thick, fleshy stems and leaves. Be sure you can positively identify it before eating!

PURSLANE BASIL PESTO

Recipe adapted from
<https://www.twopeasandtheirpod.com/spinach-basil-pesto/>

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup olive oil
- 6 cups packed purslane, basil leaves, spinach leaves, or any combination of greens
- 1/4 cup parmesan cheese
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder or 2 cloves garlic, roughly chopped
- 2 Tbsp lemon juice or 2 teaspoons of sumac seasoning.
- salt and pepper, to taste
- Optional: 1/4 cup nut or seed of your choice

Steps:

- Place all ingredients into a food processor or blender. Blend for 15-30 seconds. Stop and scrape sides with spatula. Blend again for 15-30 more seconds, or until smooth.
- Pesto may be used as a sauce on pizza, sandwiches, eggs, fish, chicken, or veggies.
- Freeze if desired for later use.

A visitation will be held on Wednesday, July 24, 2024, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Buswell Funeral Home.



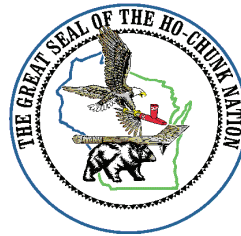

Child Support Director Linda Buse mentions the Nations laws are great. The problem is with the laws in Wisconsin that will only allow child support be deducted from income. The General Welfare payments are declared non-income and cannot garnish by the State. That is why it is done by a voluntary deduction.

Community Health Care

Rep. Sarah Lemieux-White Eagle mentioned that when

Legislature reviewed the budgets it did not include the Home Health Care. It was asked that a plan be presented and there was to be an internal discussion. The plan was not ready at that time, and now there is an issue. Once the employees are laid off, everyone will be feeling the effects.

Samantha Casey, Community Health Director, mentioned as a result of the removing the Home Health positions from the Community Health budget, they would have to discharge 83 caseloads. A lot of the patients are high acuity and are seen 2-4 times a week and this will be detrimental.

Community Health needs all 17 positions reinstated.

Rep. Robert Pilot would like to know how the Legislature can fix this immediately.

Legislative Counsel Michael Murphy mentioned that the Budget Act says that once the Budget Bill is adopted there is a process to go through to make any true increases. Legislative Counsel recommended to first have a Finance Commission to approve a true increase on an emergency basis, and then have a Legislative Meeting. They can happen as a "special" or "emergency" meeting, and a resolution prepared.

Notice is hereby served to all eligible voters of District 1. The Ho-Chunk Nation is calling a Special Election which will be held due to the Resignation of Legislator Karena Thundercloud, District 1, Seat 1 effective July 6, 2024. The Ho-Chunk Nation Election Board, in accordance with the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation will conduct a Special Election. ARTICLE IX< SECTION 10, Removal, Recall and Vacancies and the Election Code 2 HCC Sec. 6, states in relevant part:

ARTICLE IX-REMOVAL, RECALL VACANCIES

Section 10. Vacancies in the Legislature. If a vacancy occurs in the Legislature because of death, mental or physical incapacity, removal or recall vote, resignation, felony conviction, or for any other reason, such vacancy shall be filled in the following manner:

- (a) If three (3) months or more remain before the next General Election, the Election Board shall call a Special Election in the appropriate District to be held within thirty (30) days.

ELIGIBLE VOTERS:

Any enrolled member of the Ho-Chunk Nation who is at least eighteen (18) years old and who has resided in their respective district for at least three (3) months. See *Election Code Sec. 11 (a) (b).*

REGISTRATION:

Each person seeking to vote must register at the polling place by showing identification before receiving an Official Ballot. If a person cannot write, that person must sign his/her name with a mark before two (2) witnesses

ELIGIBILITY DISPUTES:

Any individual whose name does not appear on the eligible voters list can claim the right to vote by presenting a written challenge to the Election Board. Any eligible voter may challenge the eligibility of an individual’s name appearing on the eligible voters list by presenting a written challenge to the Election Board.

The Election Board shall rule on all written challenges to the list of eligible voters immediately after the close of the challenge period, Section 11. c. ii. (Deadline, Tuesday, July 16, 2024).

ABSENTEE VOTING:

A voter may vote by absentee ballot provided the Election Board receives the absentee ballot request in writing no later than Saturday, July 27, 2024, by 4:30 P.M. See *Election Code, Page 26, Sec. 13 (a) (i)* Requests MUST INCLUDE the eligible voter’s name printed or typed (with signature), physical address where the ballot will be delivered (we use UPS next Day Air – UPS Next Day Air will not deliver to a P.O. Box), daytime telephone number and enrollment number.
