A Bear Writes Poetry

Ho-Chunk author Sherman Funmaker hosted a poetry reading at the Tomah Community Center on August 1, inviting area residents to dive into the creative world of one of the oldest forms of Japanese poetry: the haiku.

Attendees were encouraged to brainstorm 17-syllable haikus on various subjects, both those presented by Funmaker and those of their own choosing.

Funmaker, a 72-year-old member of the Bear Clan, grew up in Wisconsin. He was born in Black River Falls and moved frequently during his childhood. He began his early life in Milwaukee, eventually attended grade school in the Dells area, and graduated high school in Mauston.

His inspiration for poetry was ignited at UW-Baraboo, where he graduated in 2006 with a degree in English. Funmaker credits his professors with his development, admitting that he had never really written before. "At first, I didn't really know how to... write? It was hard at first. It was like, 'How do I do this?'"

Reflecting on his time at UW-Baraboo, Funmaker cited the



vibrant school environment as a profound source of inspiration. "Getting together, meeting new people, meeting young people, meeting creative people—you know, artists, writers, singers, dancers; I loved that! Because I was 50, these other kids were early 20s."



Overcoming the challenges of being a new author was difficult at first, but after a period of trial and error, Funmaker found writing to be therapeutic. It became an outlet for expressing his emotions and sharing his thoughts with the world.

What started as writing challenges

from professors gradually evolved into writing screenplays and movie plots. In 2010, Funmaker co-directed a screenplay for UW-Baraboo and created a short film featuring dialogue specifically in Ho-Chunk.

Hand-in-Hand Cooperation: Ho-Chunk Nation and Brockway Collaborate on Road Rehabilitation Projects

The Ho-Chunk Nation and the Town of Brockway have come together once again to tackle inadequate roadways that trouble the surrounding area of Black River Falls.

This collaboration, aimed at improving local infrastructure, highlights the commitment of both parties to enhancing the quality of life for residents and ensure safer transportation routes.

The two new projects have been developed under

cooperative agreements to establish a mechanism for the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) to support this initiative. The BIA has allocated tribal transportation program funds for the rehabilitation of Highland Road and Paul Road.

The Town of Brockway will oversee the engineering services, such as the design, project plans, written specifications, and construction of both projects. The Ho-Chunk Nation Transportation Authority will perform inspections and notify the

town in writing of any concerning defects or issues.

The specific scope of the project involves the comprehensive reconstruction and paving of Highland Road and Paul Road. These upgrades are expected to significantly improve the driving conditions and safety for all who use them.

The estimated cost of both projects totals \$292,618.00. Both projects are estimated to be completed by the end of September, later this year.

Jeremy Head

November 13, 1976 - July 28, 2024

For his short 47 years on our shared little rock, not many individuals could make a person smile, laugh, or to simply feel seen more so than Cha Pa Ga – otherwise known as Jeremy Head. His natural inclination to bring a person in and laugh with them affected the numerous people he came to know during his time spent here. As an innate performer, he would display this from the stage by (poorly) playing guitar, evoke laughter during his comedy shows, sing karaoke, or DJ at only the finest of drinking establishments. In a less formal setting he was always cracking jokes, looking for that next chuckle out of you while shooting pinball or watching wrestling.

He was a man of many names: Head, Meatloaf, Head Brother, Kunu, Gemy, the middling-tier Pool Hall King of the Midwest (self-issued), and was loved by all (or at least most) that met him.

Jeremy passed away on July 28th at Mayo Hospital in Eau Claire, WI due to numerous health complications. He was preceded in death by Cheryl Thundercloud

(mother) and survived by Cecil Thundercloud (brother), Stephanie Szajna (niece), Maxwell Thundercloud (nephew), and countless friends and cousins who loved him dearly. Services will be held in Black River Falls, WI on Saturday, August 3rd from 11 to 2 at District 1 Community Center. 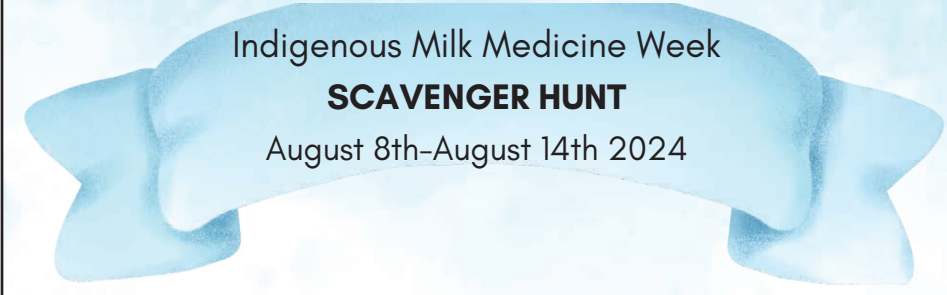

Location: HCN Legislative Conference Room, W9814 Airport Road, Black River Falls, WI 54615 and Virtually

Purpose: To review actions taken by HCN Social Services – Child and Family Services

Potential Topics:

- Concerns from Parties to CFS cases
- Appropriateness of terms and conditions of employment/job descriptions
- Proper use of appropriated budgets and obtaining necessary and appropriate outside funding to offset NPD funds
- Appropriateness of the Nation's laws and services that may contribute to the social advancement of its Members in the realm of child welfare
- Progress or deviation from the goals and objectives of the Departmental Strategic Plan

Legal Authority: Pursuant to the HO-CHUNK NATION CONSTITUTION, Art. V, Sec. 2(b), the Legislature has the power to "establish Executive Departments, and to delegate legislative powers to the Executive branch to be administered by such Departments, in accordance with the law; and Department established by the Legislature shall be administered by the Executive; *the Legislature reserves the power to review any action taken by virtue of such delegated power*". Additionally, the Legislature is charged with the protection of Ho-Chunk culture and traditions, and the promotion of public health and other services that may contribute to the social advancement of Ho-Chunk members pursuant to the HO-CHUNK NATION CONSTITUTION, Art. V, Sec. 2(r); (s).

Open Meetings Act: The Investigative Hearing for CFS will be held in Open Session. However, due to the sensitivity of the subject matter and in recognition of the public safety and well-being of the Nation (including the Nation's members), individuals/families who wish to testify will be called in one individual/family at a time in Executive Session. OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 2 HCC § 2.6; LEGISLATIVE ORGANIZATION ACT OF 2011, 2 HCC § 11.20d; 22f. Proper Releases of Information are required to be used in order for CFS to provide any comments on case specific details.

Written Comments: Written Comments may be sent in advance of the Investigative Hearing to Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature, Attn: Legislative Counsel, P.O. Box 667, Black River Falls, WI 54615, along with a proper release of information. Comments from families will be included in the record of Executive Session.

Time Slots & Limits: Community Members/Families will be limited in time, to be determined, to ensure a fair opportunity for all to participate. In order to ensure such fairness and confidentiality, time slots will be used.

ATTENTION DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING RENTAL MANAGEMENT TENANTS:

As of July 1, 2024 the Department of Housing Rental Management Division made the decision to move forward with Lease Terminations due to non-payment.

The arrearages amounts have been categorized into 3 tiers.

Tier 1: \$9,000.00 - \$20,000.00 of rental arrearages will be an **automatic Non-Renewal of Lease and immediate Notice to Vacate**. Failure to comply with Notice will result in eviction. This decision is final.

Tier 2: \$4,000.00 - \$8,999.99 of rental arrearages will result in a Notice to set up a payment plan to pay the debt owed. Your rent is to be paid in full each month along with agreed arrearage payment amount. Failure to comply with Notice will move your account to Tier 1 and result in a Non-Renewal of Lease.

Tier 3: \$1.00 - \$3,999.99 of rental arrearages will result in a Notice to set up a payment plan to pay the debt owed. Your rent is to be paid in full each month along with agreed arrearage payment amount. Rental Management will work with you to bring your account current.

Per the signed Lease Agreement with The Ho-Chunk Nation Department of Housing, rent payments are due on the 1st of every month with a 5 day grace period.

Per Policy: Ho-Chunk Nation Tribal Members will not be offered a rental unit if a debt is owed to The Department of Housing Rental Management Division.

The Ho-Chunk Nation is calling a Special Election which will be held due to the Resignation of Legislator Karena Thundercloud, District 1, Seat 1 effective July 6, 2024. The Ho-Chunk Nation Election Board, in accordance with the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation will conduct a Special Election. ARTICLE IX< SECTION 10, Removal, Recall and Vacancies and the Election Code 2 HCC Sec. 6, states in relevant part:

ARTICLE IX-REMOVAL, RECALL VACANCIES

Section 10. Vacancies in the Legislature. If a vacancy occurs in the Legislature because of death, mental or physical incapacity, removal or recall vote, resignation, felony conviction, or for any other reason, such vacancy shall be filled in the following manner:

- (a) If three (3) months or more remain before the next General Election, the Election Board shall call a Special Election in the appropriate District to be held within thirty (30) days.

ELIGIBLE VOTERS:

Any enrolled member of the Ho-Chunk Nation who is at least eighteen (18) years old and who has resided in their respective district for at least three (3) months. See *Election Code Sec. 11 (a) (b)*.

REGISTRATION:

Each person seeking to vote must register at the polling place by showing

identification before receiving an Official Ballot. If a person cannot write, that person must sign his/her name with a mark before two (2) witnesses

ELIGIBILITY DISPUTES:

Any individual whose name does not appear on the eligible voters list can claim the right to vote by presenting a written challenge to the Election Board. Any eligible voter may challenge the eligibility of an individual's name appearing on the eligible voters list by presenting a written challenge to the Election Board.

The Election Board shall rule on all written challenges to the list of eligible voters immediately after the close of the challenge period, Section 11. c. ii. (Deadline, Thursday, August 15, 2024).

ABSENTEE VOTING:

A voter may vote by absentee ballot provided the Election Board receives the absentee ballot request in writing no later than **Monday, August 26, 2024 by 4:30 P.M.** See *Election Code, Page 26, Sec. 13 (a) (i)*. Requests MUST INCLUDE the eligible voter's name printed or typed (with signature), physical address where the ballot will be delivered (we use UPS next Day Air – UPS Next Day Air will not deliver to a P.O. Box), daytime telephone number and enrollment number.
